If you're looking for a practical, compact campervan with room for a family but with potentially lower running costs and lower emissions than a traditionally-engined vehicle, this all-new hybrid could be just the thing.

The P\10E is the first hybrid campervan from Spanish brand Panama, and I got the chance to take a closer look at it at Blackmore Club Site in Worcestershire.

Watch Emily's

Built on the Ford Tourneo Custom Active, this four-berth model is fully ULEZ-compliant and offers potentially lower CO, emissions - 66g/km combined - with an electric driving range of up to 32 miles.

The lowdown

For a family, a couple or a solo camper looking to venture into vanlife, it could be a smart solution, especially if you're planning shorter trips, as well as a future-facing one. It's available in the UK through Marquis Leisure and dealerships in Scotland, Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland.





- 1 The compact van is just over 5m long and a little over 2m high, with four berths and five belted driving seats. It has a payload of 465kg and a range of up to 32 miles, driving solely on electric power.
- 2 Under the bonnet is a 2.5-litre Ford Tourneo Custom Active petrol engine and a 13kW plug-in hybrid battery with 11.8kW of usable energy. It benefits from an automatic gearbox, a 63-litre fuel tank and plenty of driver aids such as adaptive cruise control, reversing cameras and front and rear parking sensors for a comfortable driving experience. Green zone geofencing means the P\10E can automatically switch to electric-only driving if you enter a low-emission or clean air zone.
- 3 In the living area, the appliances are all-electric, so no gas is required. There's a side kitchen layout that has an induction hob with two burners, a fridge freezer and good storage space in rollershutter cupboards
- 4 Dimmable LED lighting is in the ceiling and there's also a dedicated space to stow the on-board toilet.
- 5 The rear bench can slide along the floor to make space where you need it and the table can be used inside or out.
- 6 There are two ISOFIX points on the bench, great if you have young children.
- 7 The pop-top roof has mosquito mesh and panoramic views and it promises a comfy night's sleep, with a high-density double mattress and a bed that's a generous 6ft 6in long.
- 8 At night, the rear seat can be made into a double bed that's just over 6ft 2in long.
