Marquis' high-spec versions of Accordo and Autoquest

TAKE some of Britain's most popular coachbuilts, from Elddis, add a dose of extra spec and sell them exclusively through Britain's largest dealer network (Marquis now has 12 branches in England, stretching from Plymouth to County Durham) and the result is the Majestic – claimed to be the UK's best-selling special edition.

There are 14 models – of which nine fit into the under-£50k sector. That's all four of the Accordo-derived compacts (read more on page 56), plus all but the six-berth 196 layout in the Autoquest-based sextet (including the little 115 – see page 21).

With their silver metallic cabs, Majestic graphics and standard alloy wheels, the Marquis versions are instantly recognisable from their standard Elddis counterparts.

More importantly, all Majestics come with the 160bhp Peugeot engine, rather than the more usual 130bhp – that should result in stonking performance for the little six-metre models.

But it's not just about more oomph under the bonnet. A tyre pressure monitoring system is standard, as is automatic cab air-conditioning and an integrated touchscreen DAB radio with Bluetooth and sat-nav. Add in a reversing camera and Thatcham-approved GPS Tracker system and you've got all the base vehicle bases covered without worrying about extra cost options. This year, Marquis is even lobbying in a year's free insurance (subject to terms and conditions) to sweeten the deal.

The Marquis models also come with a roof-

mounted solar panel, exterior shower and barbecue points, and an exclusive pet-friendly Aquaclean upholstery scheme that simply wipes clean with water.

Like the standard Elddis products, the Majestic models feature SoLiD construction, backed by a 10-year water ingress warranty. They all meet the Grade III insulation standard, too. There's also a three-year warranty on the permanently fitted habitation equipment, and three years or 100,000-mile cover from Peugeot, plus 12-months' breakdown assistance.

Tempted? Then also compare the Majestics with their Accordo/Autoquest cousins and any other dealer special derivatives available from your nearest dealers.
