**A**RGUABLY, you've already seen this new model on page 59, but such is the influence of Marquis that we've included its version in our Top 50 rundown, too. After all, Marquis is not only the UK's largest motorhome retailer, now with 12 branches, but it is part of the French Trigano Group which sells more vehicles here than any other manufacturer.

Elddis, of course, is not part of that empire but the UK arm of its German rival, the Erwin Hymer Group. Such is the long-standing nature of the Marquis/Elddis relationship that it predates the current ownership of each of these brands but the cooperation continues, based on

a proven formula. No other dealer special can claim such an established pedigree.

If you want an Autoquest motorhome with a few added toys or, maybe, a touch more style, there are plenty of dealer specials to choose from. Elddis is the unchallenged market leader when it comes to these special editions but do also look at what your local motorhome retailer may be able to offer. Think Brownhills Evolution, Dolphin/Webbs Envy, RBM Musketeer, Spinney Vogue, West Country Sunseeker and more.

The Majestic moniker has long indicated a Marquis/Elddis special and the latest models are easily identified with their silver cabs and

bespoke graphics. Other features separating them from more prosaic standard Autoquests are the powerful 160bhp Blue HDi Peugeot engine, a touchscreen DAB radio with sat-nav and reversing camera and automatic air-conditioning. Exterior barbecue and shower points are fitted, too, and a Thatcham-approved GPS tracking system should save you money off your insurance in the long run. Not that you need to worry in the first year as Marquis includes your first year's cover.

The new 194 single bed layout is the biggest change to the 2019 Majestic range, which now numbers 14 models.
